Les Chaudrons de la Dourdannerie

 $8 \, \text{km} - 2 h 15$

Departure: Bretoncelles, car park at the 'complexe sportif'.

Direction: clockwise.

Way marking: yellow panels and painted way marks.

Ease of walking: good

Terrain: dirt or stony paths (70%)

Points of interest: panoramic views, dwellings typical of the Perche.

- 1. Take the path that passes to the left of the children's play area and cross the footbridge over the **Donette**. Follow the path the length of the **Espace Naturel Sensible** (Sensitive Natural Zone) (les Vallées et Marais de Bretoncelles)*. There are explanatory panels in places. Pass behind the care home (EHPAD). On the left is the conservation orchard and further on the hives of the black bees. When you get to the road, cross over and follow the yellow Chaudrons de la Dourdannerie panel.
- 2. Walk through the hamlet of *La Pezassière*. At the hamlet of *La Dourdannerie* go down to the left, walk past the manor house on your left to meet the D918 again. Cross the road and take the path opposite. Cross the *Corbionne* and continue via *Le Bas des Aunais*.
- 3. In the hamlet of **Les Aunais** turn right towards **Le Bas de Jonville** to meet up again, on the right, the D-road. Cross over the road.
- 4. Go up towards **La Dougère** (former bread oven on the left). Turn right to go uphill through woodland onto the plateau to meet a tarmac road from **La Petite Forêt**. Bend right.
- 5. At the crossroads, turn left for **Le Frou**. Opposite the farm, take the road to the right towards **La Charmoie**. Continue past the hamlet and follow down a sunken path along the edge of a wood. After a right angle bend to the right come out onto **le chemin de la Voie**.
- 6. Keep on the path until you reach a tarmac road. Take the path opposite. Les Brissetières.
- 7. Return to the start following the D918.
